

KinderSign – Set Up Self Reset

Set up account verification so you can reset your own PIN by email or text message. You can skip this setup and complete it later.

- A** Use the keypad to enter your 10-digit telephone number, then tap **Next**.
- B** Enter your 4-digit **PIN**, then tap **Verify**.
- C** The **Set Up Account Verification** screen appears. Tap **Verify with Email** or **Verify with SMS** to select your method.
- Note:** Tap **Skip for now** if you do not wish to verify now — KinderSign takes you to the **Sponsor Activities** screen.
